THE threat to tourists in Tunisia is no worse than many other countries, a former British ambassador to Libva has claimed.

Oliver Miles said he was "puzzled" by the repatriation of tourists this week, adding "there have been appalling incidents all over the place".

The Government has advised against "all but essential travel", after the beach massacre that saw 38 people killed in Sousse.

But Mr Oliver said: "On the same day as Sousse there was an outrage in Kuwait, one in France, one in Egypt, two days later there was one in Yemen.
