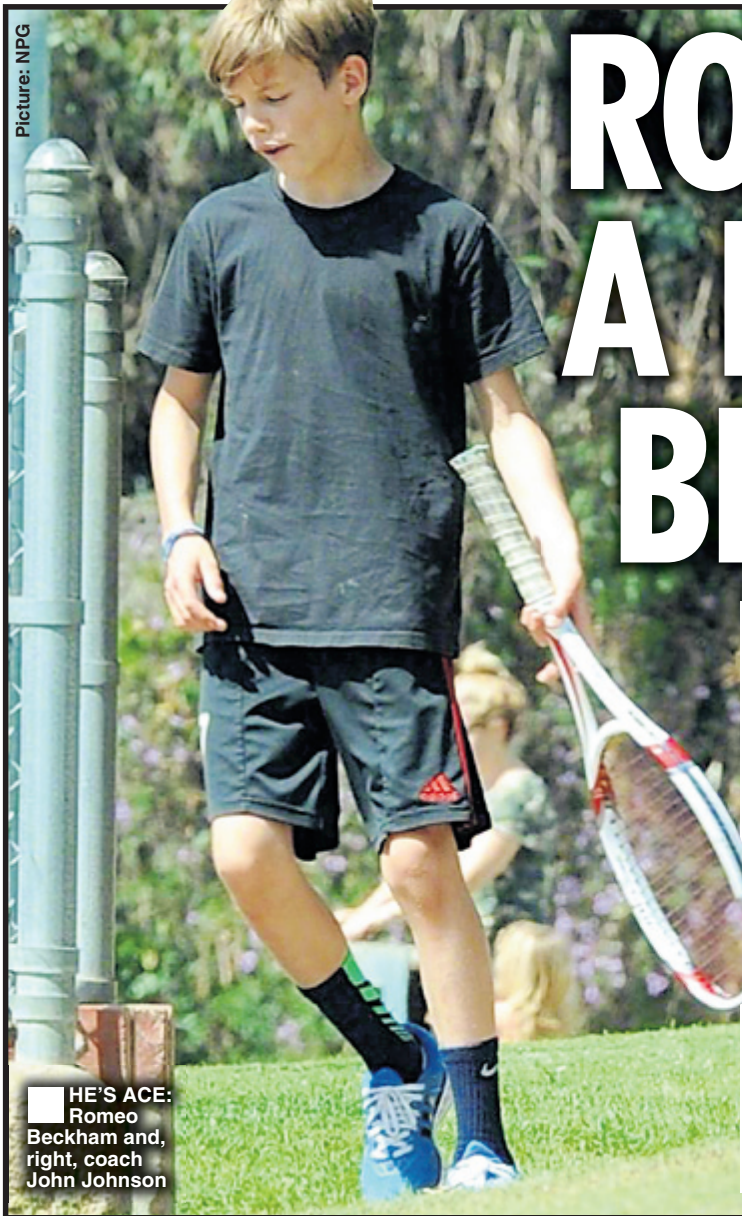

DAVID Beckham's son Romeo has been hailed as a tennis star of the future.

The 12-year-old youngster wowed coach John Johnson after going for lessons at a council court.

And John said last night: "I'm not sure his parents realise just how good he is."
