## X FACTOR star Zayn Malik is set to make a shock return to the show – as a judge.

Boss Simon Cowell hopes the hunky singer will draw in an army of teenage fans to boost viewing figures.

Simon 55, believes signing up one of his One Direction boys, who found fame on the TV smash, would be a hit.

Ex-bandmate Louis Tomlinson, 23, was rumoured to be in the picture.
